Alwyn's Crosses

These crosses in a wide variety of styles are suitable for cards, bookmarks or little gifts. They can be worked on either evenweave or Aida.

Material:

14 count Aida or 28 count evenweave

Threads:

DMC stranded cotton

310 black

304 Christmas red

Any scraps of thread can be used but dark tones are most effective

Stitches used:

Back stitch

Cross stitch

Mill Glass seed beads 2011 Victorian gold

Tapestry needle No. 24

Beading Needle

Method:

Start from the centre of each design working outwards using ONE strand of cotton for the back stitch and TWO strands for the cross stitch. Outline any of the designs in back stitch after working the cross stitch to create a neater finish.
